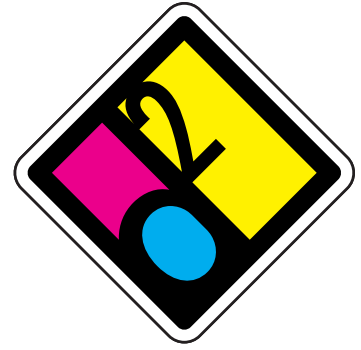


# PLOTTER CUT GLASS GRAPHICS CARE & CLEANING



## CONGRATULATIONS

You have just had a plotter cut glass graphics professionally installed by dākisdesigns.

In order for your film to cure properly to the glass, the following steps should be taken:

Do not wash the window film for 30 days after installation.

Depending upon the film type, proper curing of the window film could take up to 90 days.

During the curing process you may see a “white haze” or “fogging” of the material. You may also see “dimples” or “bubbles” in the film. These are created by the application solution which, will collect and evaporate through the pores of the film. As the material cures it will lay flat to the glass.

Cleaning:

For best results clean your windows with a squeegee and solution of a mild soap and water. If the film does not cover the whole piece of glass, please be conscious of the film edge. When cleaning the film, be sure to wipe from the center out; always stepping down along the film edge, not up. If you need to wipe the graphic, it is best to use a lint free towel.

Most decorative films and vinyls have a scratch resistant finish, but are not scratch proof. Do Not use any abrasive materials to clean or buff the window glass.

Tape residue is not easily removed. Do not use tape on the window films. Suction cups or 3M Command Strips are recommended.
